EMT110: Emergency Medical Responder***

Starts September 14th, on Mondays from 9:00am - 11:00am

This is a three (3)-credit hour course that introduces students to emergency medicine. It should be taken BEFORE EMT 100. The First Responder course provides the majority of the information covered in EMT 100, including patient assessment, lifting and moving, and treatment of traumatic injuries. This course provides preparation for EMT 100 training. Students without prior knowledge of the emergency medical services field or who have limited emergency medical services experience are advised to take this course prior to taking EMT 100.
